

A GARDEN TO HEAL THE SPIRIT

ENCINITAS ARTS RETREAT'S NATURAL SETTING OFFERS INSPIRATION

A labyrinth among the gardens at Ellen Speert's home in Encinitas welcomes guests year-round. The 1.5-acre estate, which offers sweeping views of coastal hills, also serves as a spiritual retreat known as the California Center for Creative Renewal.

Speert was working on her master of education degree in art therapy from what is now Lesley University in Boston when she was inspired to start the retreat.

"As ayoung art therapist in the 1970s, I dreamed of creating a playground for adults," she said, "observing that kids were able to spontaneously express themselves, but we grown-ups somehow lost that birthright in the process of growing up."

After graduating, Speert and her husband, Paul Henry, moved

to San Diego where she would work as a therapist and Henry as a furniture maker. In 1981, they purchased the little house on Crest Drive and she created the Art Therapy Center of North County. The concept evolved into what is now the California Center for Creative Renewal (artretreats.com).

Speert's vision for the artists' retreat included lush but waterwise gardens, a labyrinth, an indoor studio and two open-air studios. The center also includes an amphitheater for performing yoga and a deck for drumming.

"For 20 years, it was just the land and original house built in the 1940s with railroad ties by the owner who worked for the railroad," she said. "After we bought it, we immediately cleared the trash and revived the property."

In time, Speert began to offer weekly art therapy groups along with individual, couples and family art therapy.

"We also brought in a wide variety of artists and inspirational

leaders to provide exciting workshops," she said. "It is a 'journey' into self-understanding. Clients who feel confused about their direction often enjoy walking the labyrinth to get a fresh look at their lives and deepen their trust in their own wisdom and intuition."

Her efforts evolved into what she calls "eco-art therapy," with a

retreat center that serves San Diego County.

"I can mostly speak to the transformations people experience from making art and in their relationship to the gardens," she said. "With eco-art therapy, people find their own psyches and struggles reflected in the cycles of nature found here. As they see the cycle of birth and death in the garden, it mirrors their own changes, losses and the finding of new strengths."

The challenge for Speert was maintaining lush gardens in the dry, almost desert climate of San Diego.

"We installed rain barrels, which collect thousands of gallons of precious rain water, and that has been a great help," she said. "We are able to keep our water bill low."

A native pepper tree overlooks

the sedum-lined circular meditation path of the labyrinth, with lemonade berry and manzanita in the chaparral below. Visitors will also find a variety of other natural beauties, including mimosa trees, desert rose, Pride of Madeira, aloe vera, Torrey Pines and a mulberry tree.

"Since we do no advertising, word of mouth is a beautiful way the community supports us, yet many on their first visit are surprised that we are such a well-

of solace for those experiencing the loss of a loved one, or life challenges.

"We specialize in helping people move through transitions and beyond their perceived obstacles by providing individualized guidance in the use of art materials," Speert said. "At the same time, we are committed to protecting the

"We turn to art when there are no words to describe. We regain a sense of control. Art gives us a voice." Her workshops integrate nature into the process of healing.

"I have designed a playground for adults and a retreat center where people can discover their creativity while at the same time feeling held by nature in a safe and beautiful environment," Speert said.
